Ministry of Women and Child Development, Government of India confers the prestigious Pradhan Mantri Rashtriya Bal Puraskar (PMRBP) each year to give due recognition to children who have done selfless acts of exceptional bravery for others and on young children with exceptional abilities and outstanding achievements who are role models and have had widespread and visible impact on society in the fields of Sports, Social Service, Science & Technology, Environment, Arts & Culture and Innovation, which deserve due recognition at the national level. The award carries a Medal, Certificate and Citation. These awards are conferred by the Hon'ble President of India at New Delhi.

2. Any child, who is an Indian Citizen and residing in India, and not exceeding 18 years (as on the last date of receipt of application/nomination) may apply for the award. The applications for the PMRBP will be received only on the online portal <https://awards.gov.in>, designed for this purpose. The last date of receipt of online application forms is **31.08.2023**.

3. This award is the only National level Child Award given by the Government of India. In order to ensure widespread participation from all parts of the country, each district may encourage and ensure nominations of the deserving candidates who has done exceptional contribution in their field of Bravery, Sports, Social Service, Science & Technology, Environment, Arts & Culture and Innovation on the given portal.

4. You are therefore, requested to nominate the deserving candidates (at least three candidates from your district). The nominations will be accepted only through online mode on portal <https://awards.gov.in>. up to **31.08.2023**. You are also requested to give these awards wide publicity through print and electronic media and other mediums so that the award is discussed and nominations submitted from all levels including Gram Panchayats/Municipalities, etc.

5. It may be also kindly noted that the ICCW (Indian Council of Child Welfare) popularly known as the National Bravery Awards enjoys no patronage or support of the Ministry and it is not a Government sponsored award or program. Hence, you are requested not to be associated with the ICCW award nomination process in any manner and inform PRI/ZP members too to desist from any kind of involvement in the ICCW award process.
